



Flood is a rising and overflowing of a body of water especially onto normally dry land.

Flooding may occur as an overflow of water from water bodies, such as a [river](#), [lake](#), or ocean, in which the water overtops or breaks [levees](#), resulting in some of that water escaping its usual boundaries,

Floods often cause damage to homes and businesses if they are in the natural flood plains of rivers.

Some floods develop slowly, while others such as [flash floods](#), can develop in just a few minutes and without visible signs of rain.

<b>RED</b>	More than 30 mm rain Observed in 1 hour and expected to continue in the next hours	<b>EVACUATION</b>
<b>ORANGE</b>	15 - 30 mm rain Observed in 1 hour and expected to continue in the next two hours	<b>ALERT for possible evacuation</b>
<b>YELLOW</b>	7.5 - 15 mm rain Observed in 1 hour and expected to continue in the next two hours	<b>MONITOR weather condition</b>

## BEFORE

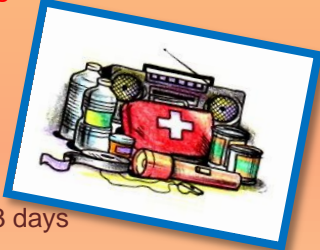
**1 Know the flood warning system in the school.**

**2 Have a handy survival kit.**

**3 Know the nearest evacuation area.**

Alamin ang pinakamalapit na ligtas na lugar na malilipatan.



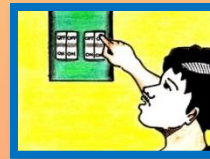
## DURING

**1 Stay alert and don't panic.**  
Panatiliing kalmado at huwag mataranta



**2 Switch off power supply.**

I-off ang pangunahing suplay ng kuryente.



**3 Watch out for rapidly rising water and prepare for evacuation.**

Bantayan ang pagtaas ng tubig at lumikas kung kinakailangan.



## AFTER

**1 Attend to victims immediately. For minor cuts and wounds, apply first aid.**

Asikasuhin ang mga biktima. Bigyan ng paunang lunas ang mga bahagyang nasugatan.



**2 Check the classroom/school community for damages and losses.**

Siyasatin ang mga silid paaralan at palibot ng eskwelahan para sa mga posibleng pinsala ng baha.



**3 Recommend to proper authorities to examine thoroughly the damaged structures and utilities before re-occupying facilities.**

Imungkahi sa kinauukulan na suriing mabuti ang kaligtasan paaralan bago ito gamitin muli.
